

Privacy Policy

At “The Howard Venue” we collect different types of information about our users for the following main reasons:

- 1) To provide a directory of hirers.
- 2) To provide information on our website of hirers.
- 3) To help us improve the services and service we offer.
- 4) To advertise hirers classes/events on social media.

Our Principles

We are committed to protecting your privacy. We will not share your information with others without your consent.

We have established the following principles:

- 1) We will not share any individual user details (including your email address) to any third party without your consent.
- 2) We will respect your email privacy. You will only receive emails regarding matters that we have received your consent for or regarding your hire.
- 3) You reserve the right to have any information we hold about you corrected.

What information do we collect?

We collect information on our users through registration.

The minimum information we need to register a user is your first and last names, address, telephone number and email address. We may ask for further information from our hirers so that we may provide a more comprehensive website, notice board, “What’s On” brochure and social media advertising.

Who will have access to your information?

Hirers name, contact phone number and email address will be visible on our website, “What’s On” brochure, notice board and social media. We will only advertise this with your consent. Therefore, anyone who visits our website, venue or who uses social media will be able to view limited personal data.

What else you should know about privacy

Remember to close your browser when you have finished your user session. This is to ensure that others cannot access your personal information and correspondence if you share a computer with someone else or are using a computer in a public place like a library or internet café. You as an individual are responsible for the security of, and access to, your own computer.

Please be aware that whenever you voluntarily disclose personal information over the internet that this information can be collected and used by others. In short, if you post personal information in publicly accessible online forums, you may receive unsolicited messages from other parties in return. Ultimately, you are solely responsible for maintaining the secrecy of your usernames and passwords and any account information. Please be careful and responsible whenever you are using the internet.
